Day 2: Read Psalm 42: 1-6

What is going on with the psalmist? What are his feelings?

What does he remember and miss doing?

Where does he meet with God? With whom does he meet with God?

Write a poem or a few sentences expressing your feelings about meeting with God in public worship.

Day 3: Read Psalm 84

Where was God's dwelling place when this psalm was written?

How does the psalmist feel about going there?

Where does he consider the happiest place to be?

What job at the temple would he be happy to have? What about you? How would you express your reactions and feelings regarding this psalm?

Day 4: Read Psalm 122

What made David glad?

What did the Israelites do when they got to the temple in Jerusalem?

What application does this have for you when you worship with other believers?

Day 5: Read 1 Peter 2: 4-9

What "picture" does Peter use to describe God's people together? What else are we?

What do we proclaim?

Where were we in the past? Where are we now?

Is this true of you? Why or why not?
